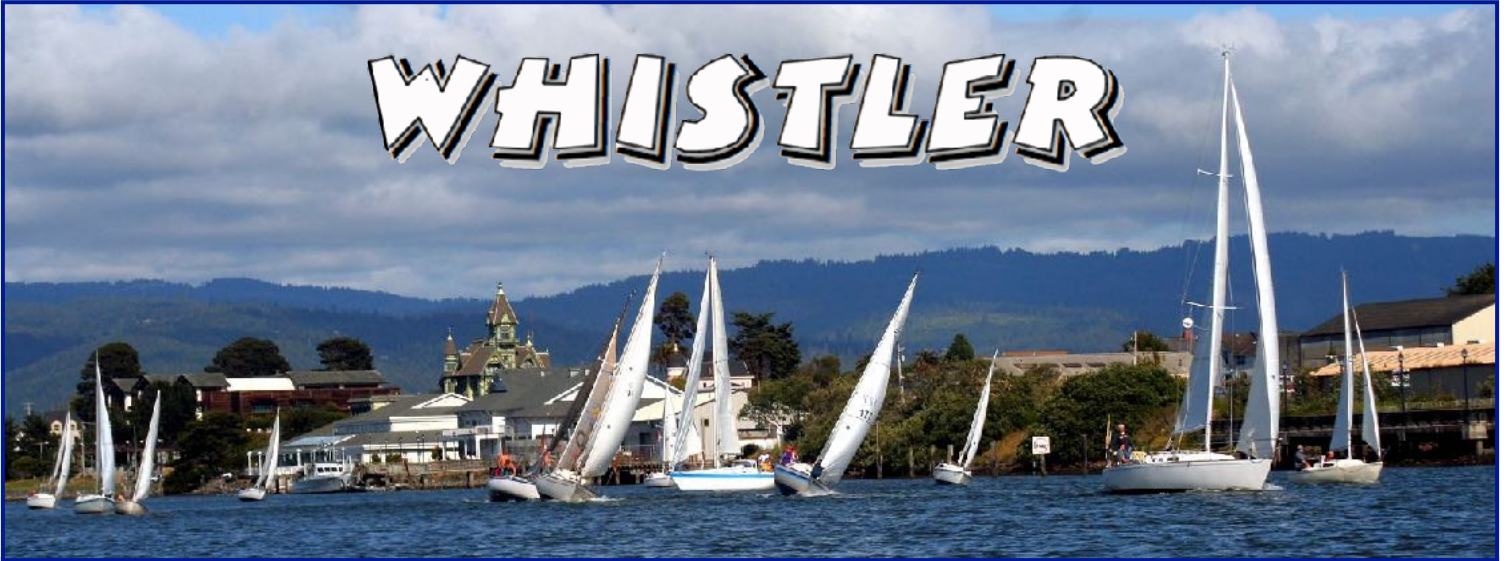

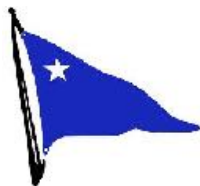
Please sign up as soon as possible to let us know you are coming. See you at the Gooner for a fun weekend.

### Junk

Another salty word washed ashore. *Junk* is the name given old rope ends that were unraveled or picked apart for later use in caulking seams aboard ship. It comes from *juncos*, the Latin name for bulrush (a source of cordage in ancient times).

The bosun of a vessel had the option of selling junk accumulated during a voyage to the "junkman" once in port, which is how that name came about.

Junk was also a sailor's slang for salt beef or pork in reference to its toughness, which was said to be on par with old rope ends.
